



INTERNATIONAL AND LOCAL ACCESSIBILITY

Cork International Airport is located off the Kinsale Road on the N27 and less than 10 minutes' drive from Cork city centre. Cork International Airport is Ireland's second largest airport after Dublin Airport.

Cork Airport is easily accessible with a good road network and regular bus services and taxis are available outside the airport terminal. There is a regular bus service to Cork city centre (Parnell Place bus station) from where you can get further connecting buses serving all the major towns in Ireland or the train from Cork Kent Railway Station. Waterford, Tipperary, Kilkenny and Kerry are also within easy reach. Car hire is available at Cork Airport in the main terminal building.

Cork Airport Taxi(s)

Are available from the front of the terminal. Cost approx €14-€16 to city centre.

Cork Air Access

Cork International Airport is easily accessible from over 60 destinations and with up to 19 flights a day from the UK and an average travel time of approximately 1 hour.
