Transport links

Nottingham is conveniently situated at the very centre of England, with excellent air, rail and road links.

By air

For domestic and European flights, Nottingham is well served by four airports, and the principal links are summarised in the chart below.

Nottingham East Midlands Airport is just 14 miles from the city centre and a direct bus service, Skylink, departs every 30 minutes to the city centre.

Robin Hood Airport, Birmingham International Airport and Coventry Airport all lie within a sixty minute drive time of Nottingham.

Airlines operating at Nottingham East Midlands Airport include bmi and bmibaby, easy jet, Ryanair and Sterling airlines. Flybe, Thomson and Ryanair are the main operators from Robin Hood Airport.

By rail

Nottingham is convenient to get to by train. East Midlands Trains services operate between Liverpool and London stations and Central Trains service the Midlands region. Average journey times from principal UK cities are set out below.

The Nottingham Convention Bureau can offer discounted tickets between Nottingham and London with East Midlands Trains. Travelling off peak can cost as little as £30 return and £40 in first class.

Eurostar

Nottingham's direct rail link with the new Eurostar terminal at London St Pancras means you can travel in luxury from the heart of Paris to the Centre of Nottingham in just under five hours. And with services from Bruges and Brussels, as well as connections to other major European cities, the Eurostar link puts Nottingham a quick relaxing train ride away from the heart of the continent.

By road

The M1 is just six miles from Nottingham city centre with junctions 24 - 26 (A453, A610 and A52 respectively) giving quick and easy access from the motorway
